Saturday 14 December

Depart Perth on Matters of Taste private bus driven by Anthony and begin our journey south to the Guadagnino family farm.

Find your seat at the long table amongst the cherry trees and sip on a chilled glass of local wine. Lisa and her team from Wild at Pemberton, cook and serve a specially designed relaxed Italian style lunch featuring local produce and of course beautiful cherries, just for us.

Ray Guadagnino will have a chat to us about what life is like on the farm during cherry season and you'll get to buy freshly picked cherries from the farm shop to take home.

After lunch there's time to check in and refresh at The Gallery Motel. As the day makes way for the evening, we'll gather *al fresco* with the sun setting to chatter about our adventure and graze on some tasty morsels.

Day 2 Sunday 15 December

Breakfast will be on the verandah, overlooking the Manjimup Heritage Park. A beautiful spread will be prepared for us and everyone can graze on their choice of dishes and sip on great coffee or tea.

On our way home there will be a brief stop in Bridgetown to visit a unique country larder. The young chef and owner will have baked fresh sourdough loaves for you to purchase and take back to Perth if you so wish. We arrive back in Perth mid-afternoon.
