Stay on afterwards to enjoy more of a look-around and join other members for coffee nearby (at own expense).

Meet in front of the Museum, which is housed inside Fremantle's historic Commissariat buildings.

Parking information: The WA Shipwrecks Museum is located within easy walking distance of Fremantle Train Station. There is a free Fremantle Cat Service that includes both the train station (stop #1) and the Museum (stop #17). Convenient paid parking is available in the Marine Terrace Car Park #2, just a short walk away.
