



## Catalpa: Flight to Freedom – Fremantle Prison

Thursday 19 March, 7- 8.45pm (approx)

Venue: East Workshops, 1 The Terrace, Fremantle

Theatre 180 presents the incredible true story of the rescue of six Fenian prisoners from the fortress of Fremantle Prison in 1876, one of the most daring and audacious prison breaks in Australia's history. Two years in the planning, it involved espionage, secret letters, undercover operatives who travelled from Boston to Western Australia to enact the plan, a love affair, a rescue ship masquerading as a whaleboat, a desperate boat chase and the threat of war against the might of America.
